

Domestic Violence Statistics for Grand Rapids, Michigan

July 2003 – June 2004

SAFE HAVEN MINISTRIES

Ramoth House:

Ramoth House served 83 women and 117 children.

80 were from Kent County, and 3 were from other areas.

24 were age 18-25, 39 were age 26 to 34, 19 were age 35-49, and 1 was 50 and older.

The average length of stay at Ramoth House was 15.6 days.

Protective Hands:

An average of 5.7 women per week participated in one of our 3 support groups.

196 new cases were opened.

1,340 phone calls were received requesting information about domestic violence and/or our services.

5.3 counseling appointments per week were held by our therapists.

47 women received counseling.

YWCA – DOMESTIC CRISIS CENTER

DCC housed 459 women and children.

230 additional assessments were made, and alternatives were sought due to a full shelter.

The average length of stay at DCC was 18 days.

MEN'S RESOURCE CENTER

103 men received an assessment.

82 of the 103 men completed the domestic violence group.
